SO WHAT HAPPENS NOW?

Between now and May, all MT 1,2 &3 will be working hard to learn all the content of the show. Songs, routines and scenes, which will then be put together to make something special. ALL rehearsals times and spaces can be found in the rehearsal schedule. This was emailed to all parents, put on our website and any other social places we could post. Please contact Darreng@nktheatrearts.org.uk, he will be able to check whether you received it or if you have accidently unsubscribed to our mailing list or any further problems.)

<u>PLEASE READ TRHOUGH THE SCHEDULE CAREFULLY</u> and note the <u>TIME CHANGES</u> (attached below). As you can imagine it has been extremely tricky to work our rehearsals around the current situation. As we can only use certain places at certain times, it is crucial we try our best to stick to this schedule where possible. I understand this can cause some confusion and it is not the ideal situation. MOANA BACKSTAGE SUPERVISION/RUNNERS.

As we are in another venue (New mills art theatre) for this production, there will be few slight changes as to how we do things.

I am looking for a team of parents to join our backstage team to help supervise and run this production.

- This team will all need to be available on <u>Sunday 28th 10am-3pm</u> to learn the show & get familiar with the theatre and new surroundings.
- They will need to be available to alternate days from the <u>1st-5th of May 2024</u> (including tech & dress on 1st & 2nd).
- Having a dbs or chaperone license is a bonus but not essential to apply at this time. We can only have a certain number of people backstage therefore; I will not be able to use everyone if we are inundated with offers unfortunately.

ON STAGE, TECH & DRESS REHEARSAL



-WHAT IS THE "ON STAGE REHEARSAL"?

The "ON STAGE" rehearsal is at the venue "new mills art theatre". This will be held (as stated in the schedule) on SUNDAY 28th April 2024. 10am-3pm. This is an <u>extremely important rehearsal</u> for everybody involved, cast and crew. This will be the first time all cast and crew will be able to get used to the new surroundings, piece together the show properly, making sure everyone knows what they are doing and making everyone as comfortable and relaxed as possible, before adding the other important elements at the tech and dress rehearsals.

- What to bring to the ON STAGE rehearsal?

. All members should wear comfortable, dance appropriate clothes. They should bring the dance shoes they will be using throughout the show (ballet or jazz shoe). Bring something quiet to do, like a coloring book, a game that can be silenced etc (For when they quite possibly will be sat around for a little while.) Water/juice only. NO FIZZY DRINKS. Lunch and plenty of snacks.

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- WHAT IS A TECH REHEARSAL?

At these rehearsals, known as "tech rehearsals," the director adds the technical elements to the production. These may include the sets, costumes, sound, lights, hand properties (or "props" – any objects the actors hold in their hands, like a pencil or a grocery bag), and even special effects. Tech rehearsals can seem long and tedious, but they are where the important details of the show are put into place and make sure it is "audience ready". We must be mindful in these rehearsals. There is an awful lot that goes into a production, not everything will go to plan. It is the cast's job to remain calm and try to enjoy the process, while the people around them will be working extremely hard to make sure they have the best show possible!

- What to bring to the TECH rehearsal?

. All members will be asked to wear black bottoms, an NK top or the Moana show top and have their hair off the face, This is because photos will be taken during this rehearsal. They should bring the dance shoes they will be using throughout the show (ballet or jazz shoe). Bring something quiet to do, like a coloring book, a game that can be silenced etc (For when they quite possibly will be sat around for a little while.) Water/juice only. NO FIZZY DRINKS. snacks.

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- WHAT IS A TECH AND DRESS REHEARSAL?

The Dress rehearsal will be very similar to the tech run but with the added element of "costumes!" and hopefully not as stop start. (Be sure to try your costumes on prior to the Dress rehearsal and make sure you can move well in them, this will help eliminate any wardrobe mishaps!

All members will be expected to arrive in their first costume. Any other costumes/props etc must be in a labeled bag. (please read section for costume information)

- What to bring to the DRESS rehearsal?

All members should arrive in their first costume. Any other costumes/ footwear must be in a labeled bag. Lots of water. Snacks that do not have the potential to stain or create a mess. Something quite to do.

We also suggest supplying a small bag of hairgrips, bobbles and any other essentials they might need.



All the hard work from all, leads up to this moment. This will be a weekend full of fun, magic, excitement and maybe some nerves! We are all in a new theatre, so it's all a little unknown, especially for those members who have never performed on a stage before. All crew will be bursting with positive energy to make sure all our members feel confident enough to go on and have the best time with their friends telling such a magical story to an even more supporting audience!

ARRIVAL for all members, for all the below dates will be the STAGE DOOR. You will find the stage door at the side of the building.

On Entry, all members and crew will be signed in. Once your child is in the building with us you are free to leave and then return to pick up at 7pm. We are aware, with where this theatre is situated, drop off and pick up might be a little slow, please bear with us to ensure we get everyone in and out safely and on time where possible.

PICK UP - All members must be picked up from the STAGE DOOR. *Times to be confirmed nearer the time, once the show has been timed.* (if we can find an easier way of getting all members in and out safely and quickly we will let everybody know)

Mama Rose is a character from the musical Gypsy. She's a bossy "stage mother" (a term for a parent who pushes their child into the performing arts in a negative manner). We've all seen these types at Little League games, beauty pageants, and everything in between. Some of us

have probably even acted this way to some degree without even knowing it! When our hearts are in the right place, we're sometimes blind to the fact that we might be stepping on someone else's toes or pushing just a little too hard.

Theatre is a collaborative effort, but it's important to remember that it's the director's role to see the big picture and guide every aspect of the production. In the case of your chosen Theatre school production, the roles of costume designer, set designer, choreographer, MD, marketing and director will likely be played by one person who is giving there "blood, sweat, and tears" to make it all happen. If the cast, stage crew, and parent volunteers do their best to work within the director's vision, your school's production will be a rewarding, resounding success!



Remember, having your child participate in theatre has little to do with creating a "star." The objective of rehearsing and presenting a musical is to provide children with opportunities to develop life skills and have fun!
