# NK Theatre Arts' Outreach Team are holding auditions for a very exciting project in conjunction with the NSPCC and York St John University.

We are looking for four experienced performers to take part in a theatre in education play which will be touring schools in Blackburn in November 2024. We are ideally looking for performers who are also competent and confident at delivering additional workshop material around the subject matter, however, training for this will be provided as part of the rehearsal process.

This is a fantastic opportunity to be a part of something that could potentially change lives. It will also provide you with first-hand experience of the professional world of theatre outside of "treading the boards".

**PLEASE NOTE:** This is a hard-hitting piece of theatre that explores 4 characters' lives and their experience of interpersonal domestic abuse and coercive control within friendships and relationships and safeguarding on social media.

The successfully auditioned will be booked for this professional acting contract lasting 6 weeks- you will be issued a paper contract which would need to be completed and returned prior to the first rehearsal. This contract will stipulate all details including rehearsals, payment and terms and conditions of employment. You will also be required to complete additional paperwork for your payment to be processed at the completion of the contract. As part of this contract, you will be expected to attend rehearsals, learn a script, and participate in training. Therefore, we are only looking for people who are able and willing to give this contract the required commitment.

The NK Theatre Arts Outreach team maintains a high level of professionalism on all projects and there are certain standards of behaviour, appearance, attitude, effort and commitment that we expect from all our performers.

**TOUR DATES:** YOU <u>MUST</u> BE AVAILABLE FOR ALL OF THE DATES ON THE FOLLOWING WEEK: **Monday 25th November - Friday 29th November 2024** 

Please note the tour will involve commuting each day to Blackburn and therefore morning call times will be early. However, we aim to be back in Manchester by 5.30pm each day.

**REHEARSAL DATES:** All rehearsals will take place from WB 14<sup>th</sup> October up to and including WB 18<sup>th</sup> November. Exact dates are outlined on the audition registration form – please ensure you look at these dates carefully and stipulate your availability as this may impact on your selection for the project if you are unable to attend the required number of rehearsals.

**DBS REQUIREMENTS:** All performers aged 18+ will be required to have a DBS certificate as part of the contract, this will be processed through NK Theatre Arts.

**TO REGISTER YOUR AUDITION:** If you are interested in auditioning for this contract then please click the link below to complete the form. For the audition you will need to prepare the relevant monologues for the character(s) you wish to audition for – these will be emailed to you upon receipt of your registration.
